Dairy Impact Program

2025 Application

The purpose of the Dairy Impact Program (DIP) is to provide reimbursement cost share funds for projects that support and improve dairy operations and the dairy industry in Kentucky. Eligibility is open to permitted Kentucky dairy producers.

The DIP is divided into 2 pathways: Sustained Impact projects and Accelerated Impact projects. Sustained Impact projects support management practices that create a solid base for dairy operations and generally reflect aspects of past KDDC programming, including the MILK 4.0 program, the Beef on Dairy Initiative, and Management Plus. Accelerated Impact projects improve operations in innovative, efficient, and/or sustainable ways. See DIP Guidelines for more information.

Both Sustained and Accelerated Impact project proposals should offer an innovative solution that improves the economic status of an operation. Preferred projects will demonstrate the ability to impact more than one entity or the community broadly, add value to dairy products, stimulate the market, diversify an operation, or benefit the economic status of a farm now and in the future.

If your project is funded, you will be required to complete an agreement form and a project completion form after purchases are verified by the regional KDDC consultant. KDDC will also request a follow-up in the year following project completion to understand the impact of the program.
